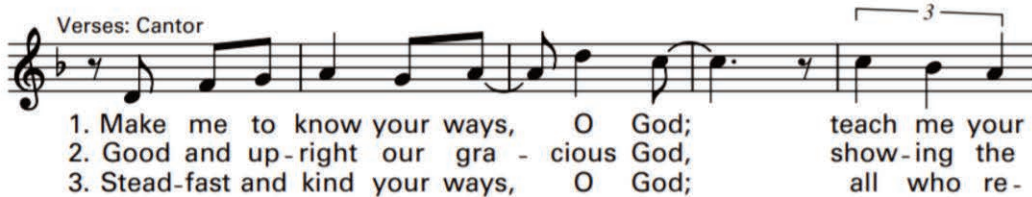
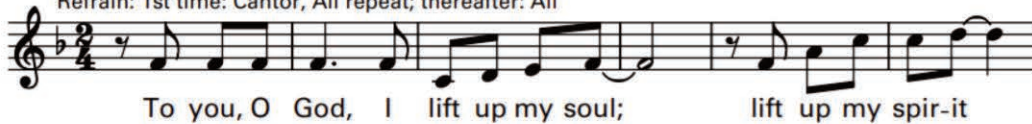



- We have 220 of our black chairs. If you want the greatest safety at the Mass on the Grass, bring your own lawn or beach chairs, and sit at a greater distance. The sound system seems to be working for those even furthest away.
- Neither the state of California nor the archdiocese have placed any age restrictions for participating. They both heavily recommend people over 65 not attend, especially if you smoke or have high blood pressure, diabetes, respiratory system disease, or cardiovascular disease.

These have been challenging times – and perhaps we will be stronger, and more aware of how to care for each other as a result. We are looking forward to seeing you online and in the backyard!

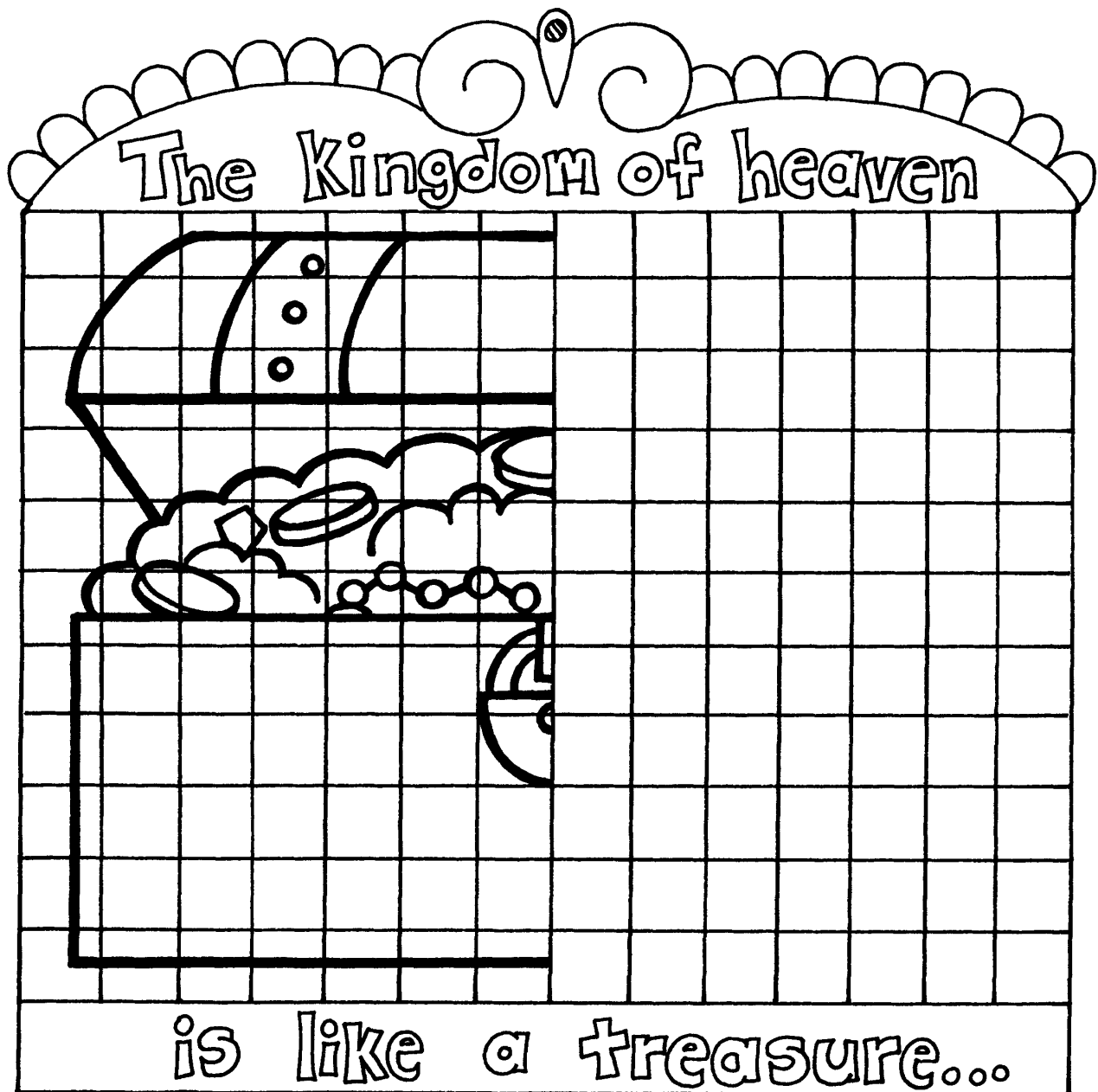

COMMUNION:

- Please, be very careful not to touch the minister's hands.
- Reverently move the host to one hand, with the other hand remove your mask, prayerfully consume the host, replace the mask and be seated.

- Be sure to maintain social distancing and your mask all the way to your car.
