



#### Jesus Has Us

Dear friends on the journey,

Today's gospel reading from Mark is a continuation of last Sunday's story of Jesus exercising his power and authority by casting out an unclean spirit from a possessed man. This week we hear that Jesus has left the synagogue and goes to Simon Peter's house to find that his mother-in-law is sick with fever. With just the grasp of Jesus' hand, the woman is healed and back on her feet, serving the guests. By evening time, word of Jesus' miracles has spread all over town, prompting people to bring their sick loved ones to Jesus so they too might be cured of their own illnesses and demons. I can just picture the scene. A long line wrapping around neighborhood of desperate and hopeful people, each of whom Jesus patiently and lovingly touches.

These miracles were not his last. We know that Jesus' remaining years of earthly ministry were filled with preaching, countless healings, and other miracles. It is through his divine nature that Jesus can perform miracles, and it is through these miracles that Jesus' identity as the Messiah, the Savior, is revealed to the people and to us. These stories and his ministry lead up to the greatest demonstration of Jesus' power to overcome death and rise to new life, bringing ultimate healing and freedom from the sin and demons in our own lives.

The human experience has never been without pain and suffering. Through the centuries, illness of mind, body, and soul has always existed. Each of has experienced tragedy, trauma, or struggle and left with feelings of overwhelm, exhaustion, and hopelessness. These last eleven months certainly demonstrate just how much devastation we as individuals, families, communities, nation, and world have endured.

I'm not sure we question or doubt Jesus' strength and power. I think the real question is: Do we believe it for ourselves and are we able surrender to Jesus with complete trust? Are we able to flock like the people of Capernaum to Jesus for help and healing? Will we allow God's love to help us heal? Or will we slink back, determined to do it on our own, and only when we have it all together present ourselves to God?

"The Church is not a museum for saints, but a hospital for sinners." I love this quote and believe this was Jesus' mission. After all, he spent more time with those who sinned, were sick, hungry, and hurting, generally the outcast of society. But I think the mission is twofold. Yes, he calls us to care for and serve the least among us. But when the table is turned and we are fighting the demons, Jesus wants us to come to him for the healing only he can provide. Through the Church's liturgy, sacraments, and community, we can find healing, peace, and hope.

So don't wait to be a shiny saint or do it on your own. Bring your struggle to Jesus: in prayer, to a trusted friend, to a professional or pastoral helper, to reconciliation, to the altar.

Our parish community has people and ministries to help. Let's walk together in trust that Jesus has us.
