





Dear Padre Serra Parishioners,

As some of you may know I have had a tough go of it lately. Your warm wishes and heartfelt prayers provided a great source of strength for my wife, Lou Ann and I, for that we send our deepest appreciation. I was confined to the hospital for a little over six weeks from December 1st to January 16th. As horrible as that seems it provided me an opportunity to reflect on a lot of things. Especially my faith and what makes us a family here at Padre Serra. This past political season has brought a great divide in our parish family, a divide that should not exist in a loving family. That is one thing I've learned over the many years as a member of this great community. We are bound by love whether Republican or Democrat, liberal or conservative. I have this situation in my own family, but it doesn't mean that I love them any more or less.

Secondly, I had a lot of time to reflect on my faith. I'm a simple man and I try not to make things too complicated, I struggled with many ailments while in the hospital and still do today. It's going to be a long haul, but this is not about me, it's about us. No matter what circumstances divide us, there are always three things that join us: faith, hope, and love. Our faith in Jesus Christ as our Lord and Savior outshines all the darkness and the things that divide us. He died on a cross for our sins and divisions. The hope that the Holy Spirit brings to each one of us is that we might have true life more abundantly. I don't think Christ came to this earth for our earthly desires like money and property, but I think it was for the building up of true relationships here in our community. Strong, healthy, loving bonds that unite us all to one another. We must live as one in Christ, for it is his pure love that lives in each one of us separately and collectively. God sent us his only Son, his pure love. It is through this love that binds us that we can achieve true abundance and the things that really matter. We have three tools to work with: faith, hope, and love. "But the greatest of these is love." Use your tools wisely and often, share them with one another.

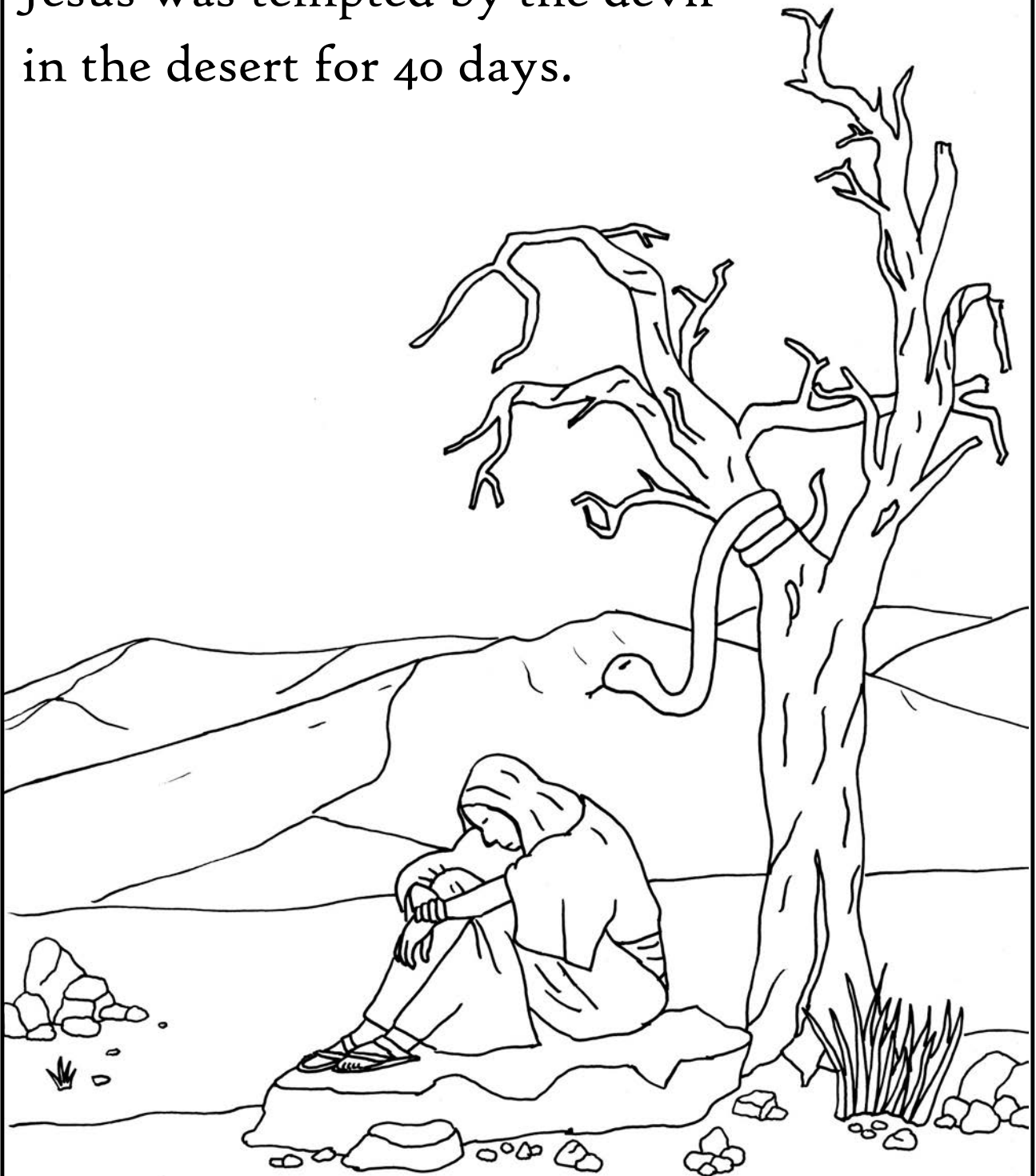

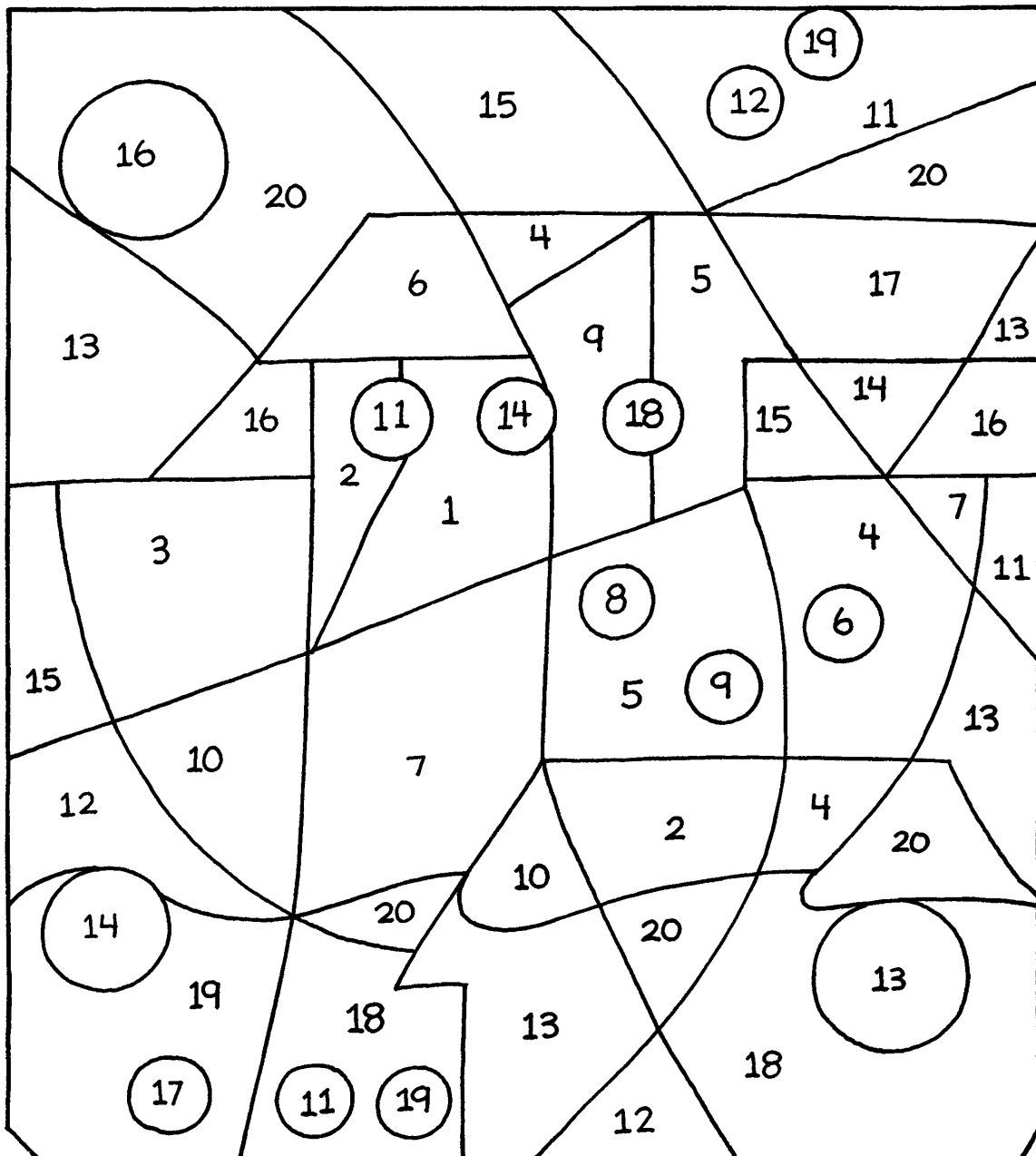
