## Speak, Lord, for your servant is listening

Dear Parish Family,

I think many of you would agree that this past year till now we have been living an extended Lenten season. Because of the pandemic, we have been forced to “give up” or “take on” so much more than what we would have ever chosen to do on our own. For many completely changing our lives, now having to work from home, distance learning, and even online Mass! We have had to give up our everyday routine, gatherings in person, social outings, going out to dinner. “Taking on” wearing masks correctly and sanitizing everything, keeping our distance from others, to make sure we keep each other safe and healthy. This sacrifice is much better than “giving up chocolate,” would you agree?

In giving up some of our everyday activities it allowed us to free ourselves up and focus on other things. To see what in our lives truly holds value. In this pandemic, one of the things I hear most often is that we miss spending time with those we love most. We have experienced such longing. At one point during our first shutdown last year and we could not attend Mass in person, like so many of you, I longed to receive Jesus in the Eucharist! Once I was again able to receive the Eucharist, what a joyous day! It took me not being able to receive him to realize how much my soul always NEEDS Jesus. For many of us, we will never again take for granted the gift to receive Jesus every week or daily.

As I begin my Lenten journey this year I think about what else can I do to bring me closer to our Lord. This week’s Gospel message is so perfect. In our Gospel this week, Peter, John, and James accompanied Jesus to the quiet mountaintop to pray, they were witnesses to Jesus transfigured in his glory, in dazzling white garments and shining like a light. We know they were so terrified they didn’t know what to say. Just then they heard a voice from heaven saying, “This is my chosen Son; listen to him.” It’s as if God the Father is telling them, “Don’t say anything. Just listen!” Listen to Jesus. Allow Him to speak to you.

This seems to be something we all need to be told from time to time. So often our lives are filled with so much noise, we can become afraid, even terrified, of silence. This includes, of course, in our prayer. So, we might set aside time to pray, and then, fill up the entire time with our own voice. Those of you who know me know how much I love to talk, so this is a challenge for me. Even when we don’t know what to say in prayer, we keep talking anyway. During this season of Lent, I invite you to join me in allowing ourselves to remain in silence. In doing so, we are giving Jesus an opportunity to truly speak to us, as we strive even more to listen to Him.

The story of Jesus' transfiguration is full of symbolism. The images of cloud and mountain suggest God's appearance at the covenant-making on Mount Sinai. Moses, the major figure in Exodus and Sinai covenant, represents the law, and Elijah, a great ninth-century prophet of Israel, represents the prophets. Jesus is the fulfillment of the law and the prophets. The disciples had a very intense experience of Jesus on the mountain. Have you ever had a "mountain top" experience? What was it like for you? In what ways does Jesus speak today, ways in which you can truly "listen to him?"
