We have all heard the term “sheep” used as an insult. Someone who lacks independent thought and is a thoughtless follower. We’ve heard it a lot during election season and we will continue to hear it when people are unkind to other people’s beliefs.

We always preach that living your Catholic faith is countercultural in many ways. A prime example of Christ turning the world upside down (even if it’s in present times) is seen within John 10.

Yes, Jesus calls us His sheep. No, it not meant to be demeaning, it’s quite the opposite. Jesus is truly the Good Shepherd willing to die for His flock. Why? Simply because He loves us.

Like I said, if we were to be called sheep in this day and age, it holds a negative connotation. Don’t let that deter you from embracing the loving message of this Gospel. Instead focus on Jesus, the good shepherd, who does not protect us for His own benefit, but rather, yearns for us to be at peace.

I find this Gospel hilariously relevant to what we experience today. Jesus not only mentions the wolf but also the shepherd who is hired and is only concerned about pay. 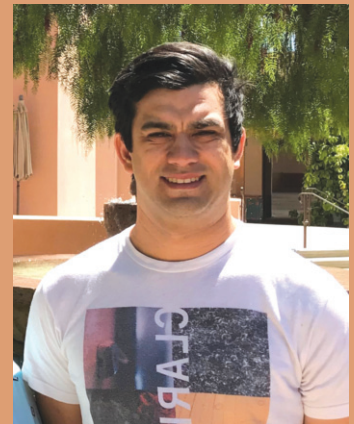

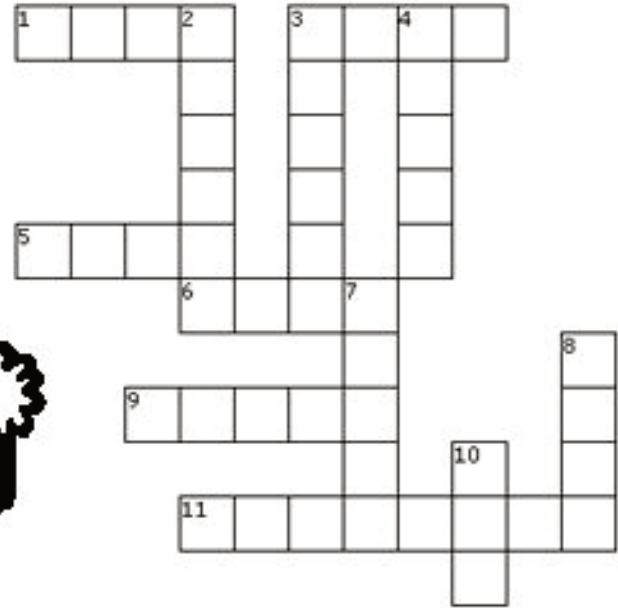
