We have not learned the new story ...

I spent the afternoon of Mother's Day with my mother. It was good to see her. During our conversation that afternoon, she told me that had this strong sense that she had to let go of the things that she could no longer do and be grateful and celebrate the things that she could. She told me how happy she was as a result. She shared this with Monsignor Paul Albee, her pastor, when he stopped by to visit her. Msgr. Albee told her that she had received a revelation from God and they celebrated.

I thought about this in relation to my own life. I have been struggling to let go as I prepare to retire from Aerospace in the next 6 months. That will mark the culmination of a 42-year career. I have been re-reading articles and books by Fr. Thomas Berry. One thing he wrote that stands out for me is, "... We are between stories. The old story is no longer effective. Yet we have not learned the new story."

We are not just observing salvation history as presented in the Gospels from the Incarnation, to Jesus' death and Resurrection, his Ascension, and now the coming of the Holy Spirit. Certainly these are all important to us and our faith journey but there is a meaning that reveals itself in our lives. We are celebrating transitions and key milestones in our lives as well. There are new births, marriages, graduations, new jobs. These and so many others are joyful events. There are more difficult transitions as well, the death of loved ones, the loss of relationships, the loss of a job. These are very difficult disorienting events.

We are beginning to emerge from the isolation of the Pandemic and just like all the other transitions in our lives we find that we are between stories. The old story is no longer effective. Yet we have not learned the new story. The challenge before us is to be grateful for what we have trusting that the Spirit will help us learn the new story as we continue through Pentecost and this new beginning in the days, weeks, and months ahead.

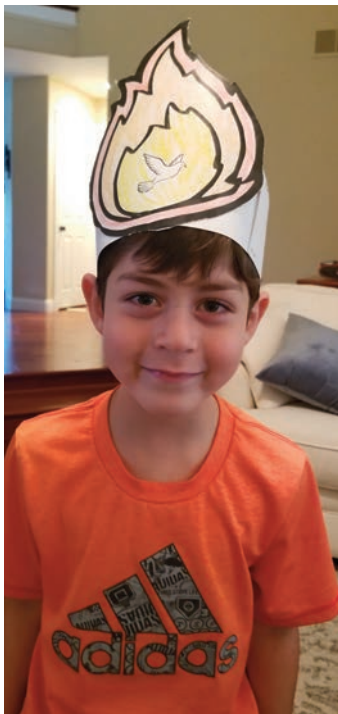

The Sacraments

The seven sacraments are essential to the Catholic way of life. They are blessed encounters with the risen Jesus. Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist are called the Sacraments of Initiation because they incorporate us into His saving death and resurrection. Baptism and Confirmation are not repeatable because they give us an "indelible mark" as members of the Body of Christ. Eucharist, the high point of our initiation, can be received daily, but at least on Sundays. The Eucharist nourishes and strengthens us to live as disciples of Jesus. It is also a sign of unity with Jesus and with each other. 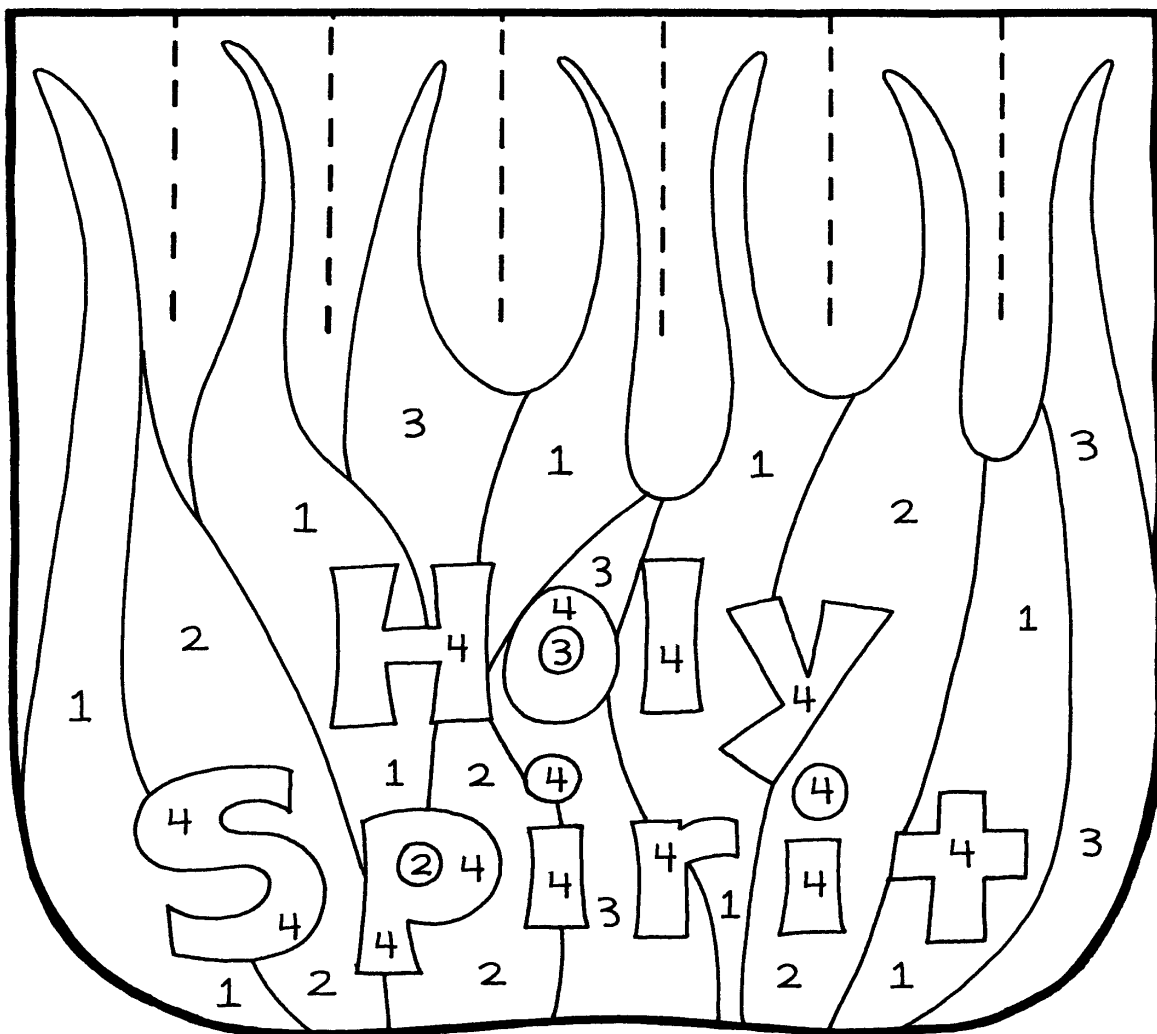
