





The Apostles' Creed



Dear Faith Family,

Before I had kids, I feel like I had a good understanding of who God is. I was raised Catholic, made my faith a priority in my life and studied theology in college. Just like everyone, I had my ups and downs, but the idea of God was understood within them. I also had a great family who were great examples of God's love. I was blessed.

When I had kids, things changed. The idea of God as my Father somehow became more clear.

Sure, it can be easy to say that God created all things and because of that, He is the Father of all created things. But when I became a father myself, I learned through my imperfections that God is the perfect Father. His unconditional love and that he is yearning to spend eternity with me in paradise has become more clear to me.

I try my hardest, but like any other person, I can fail at unconditional love. Our God does not ever fail at this.

This idea became so clear to me once I had kids and it has helped me to become a better father. Although I have selfish streaks, I can look to my heavenly Father to take a stab at being a good dad.

While we may not be called to physically die for our families, we can sometimes be called to die in little ways for them. We may not become greater because of our love, but we are willing to sacrifice ourselves for our loved ones because it benefits them.

You deserve this day, father figures. Your unconditional love has helped others to see who God really is.




