# Birth of John the Baptist

This past week we celebrated the feast of the Nativity of John the Baptist on June 24th. It's an unusual celebration. We usually commemorate saints on the day when they died, honoring their rebirth into the heavenly Kingdom. This feast of John's birth obviously doesn't follow that pattern.

It is biblical, though, recounted in Luke 1:5-25, where the priest, Zechariah, received a visit from the angel Gabriel, announcing that he and his wife Elizabeth, in their old age, would have a son they were to name John. The birth narrative continues in vv. 57-66, along with a lot of amazement.

Revealing a very literal, calendar consciousness, John's birth is celebrated three months after the Feast of the Visitation, on March 25th, when Gabriel appeared again, this time to Mary. Besides telling her of the birth of Jesus, Gabriel also announced that her kinswoman, Elizabeth, was at that very moment six months pregnant (Luke 1:36). As I said, in a very literal fashion, if Elizabeth was 6 months pregnant on March 25th, John was born in a timely way, three months later on June 24th. Do the math.

But that's not all there is to it.

John's birthday, on June 24th, is also just days away from the Summer Solstice on the twenty-first, after which the days will begin to grow shorter till the Winter Solstice, on December 21st. You'll notice that's just days before Christmas, when the days begin to lengthen again. The whole scheme is a celebration of John's words, while speaking of Jesus, "He must increase, but I must decrease" (John 3:30).

The very days of the year embody this reality, growing shorter after John's birth, and lengthening after Jesus', inviting us into a reflection of where we are with him.

Are we willing to decrease our will, our waywardness, our sense of importance, any self-centeredness, so that Jesus can increase within us? What it would be like if there was a buildup of Jesus presence in your life. What would happen to your prayer life? What would happen to the way you conduct yourself at work or at home? What would be the difference in the way you parented your children and shared your life with your friends? If Jesus had a richer part in your affairs, would it change either your morning or evening routines? Would it affect the way you drove, or spoke to the clerk at the register of the grocery store, or the way you reacted to the agent who picked up the phone after you were on hold for twenty minutes?

John's model sets us up for an aspirational goal. We will struggle towards Jesus, and never quite make it to the place of our satisfaction, but we just might make a lot of progress anyway, even as we stumble repeatedly.

The wonderful thing about Jesus is that he is not inclined to take offense at our mistakes, when they are well intentioned. We see that in our Gospel today. Jesus takes no offense at the hemorrhaging woman, even though she presumes upon his capacity to heal. Instead, he calls her "daughter," and tells her to go in peace, after he heals her. Then again, when the family of Jairus, who are distraught at the death of his daughter, ridicule Jesus, he puts them out, but resuscitates Jairus' daughter anyway. Jesus doesn't let the woman's presumption, or the family's rude treatment, in the midst of their grief, get in the way of the good he intends to do for them.

So it will be with us, especially if we do what that woman and Jairus did: they acted as though Jesus was their hope, and it proved to be true. They gave him more room in their life, and he made the most of it.

I invite you to consider making John the Baptist's words your own: "Jesus must increase, and I must decrease." You will have no reason to regret it if you do, and much to profit.
