





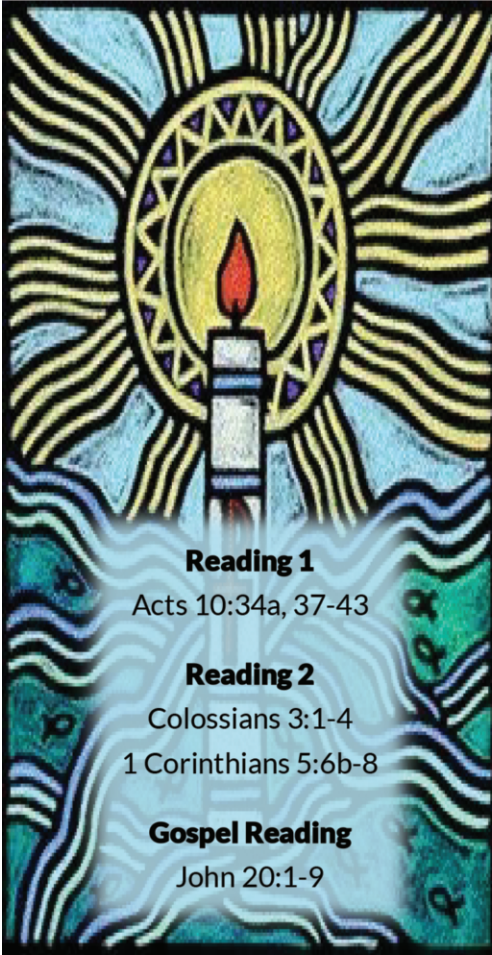
The donation truck will be in our parking lot to collect your gently used items: clothes, shoes, kitchen items, DVD/CD, luggage, sports gear, books, and toys.

Time to leave the Tomb?

I hope you had a good Lent. No. I hope you had a great Lent, using the graces that flow from the generous gift of self that comes from service of others, from alms giving, perhaps to Ukraine relief, and from attentiveness to prayer. Having said that, I know that I am ready for Lent to be done. Our two Passion readings, on Palm Sunday and Good Friday are so powerful, but maybe emotionally exhausting. I say, enough with tombs.

For that to be possible, and to do Easter well, perhaps we need to leave the tombs of our own construction? And yes, we can be living tomb makers. It might seem overly obvious that one shouldn't spend too much time among the dead, but in my experience, there are some of us who are metaphorically entombed, and need to experience the resurrection.

Consider if any of the following apply to you:

- Bitterness and resentment are tombs. We're not really fully alive so long as we are chained to our own angry resentment. It constricts our attention and smothers our happiness. For a worthy Easter, give up resentments, if you have any.
- Addiction is a tomb. You might think of addiction as a slow death, but from the moment drugs or alcohol take control of our ability to function and choose for ourselves, a part of us is dead. For a day of Easter grace, be sober, just for today in union with your higher power, the Risen Lord.
- Anger is a tomb, especially if we let it dominate and overwhelm our other emotions of frustration, anxiety, loneliness, aggravation, and irritation – none of which are “anger” and all of which are best expressed calmly. Our capacity to feel richly and broadly dies when we let anger rule our emotions. For a calm and peaceful Easter, stay cool and collected, regardless of what *anyone* else says or does.
- Selfishness is a tomb. As soon as others figure out that we're all about ourselves, they'll back off, knowing that anyone who is all about her or himself can't possibly be about them too. Selfishness is a very lonely kind of tomb. For a truly Christ-like Easter, be generous. Help someone out. Say something nice to someone else. Be a real friend.
- Hypocrisy is a tomb. Jesus referred to the scribes and Pharisees of his day as “whitened sepulchers,” because, though they had a reputation for holiness that goodness, in Jesus' eyes, didn't extend into their hearts. It might be hard for us to perceive our own hypocrisy, but that is why we have friends and family. They will know with certainty those places where we are false. What we're aiming for is integrity, wherein our inner and outer lives are parallel, connected in honesty. For an upright Easter, pleasing to the Father, say only the good things people need to hear, say “yes” when you mean “yes,” and “no” when you mean “no.” Be both honest and transparent, and perhaps silent when the truth is harsh.

My prayer for you this Easter, is that you are fully alive, intimately connected to the saving graces of our Risen Lord, close to your friends, and even closer to your family. I pray that you are free from weakness, falsehood, bitterness, addiction, anger, selfishness and hypocrisy. I pray that your Lenten sacrifices might lead to authentic Easter joy!

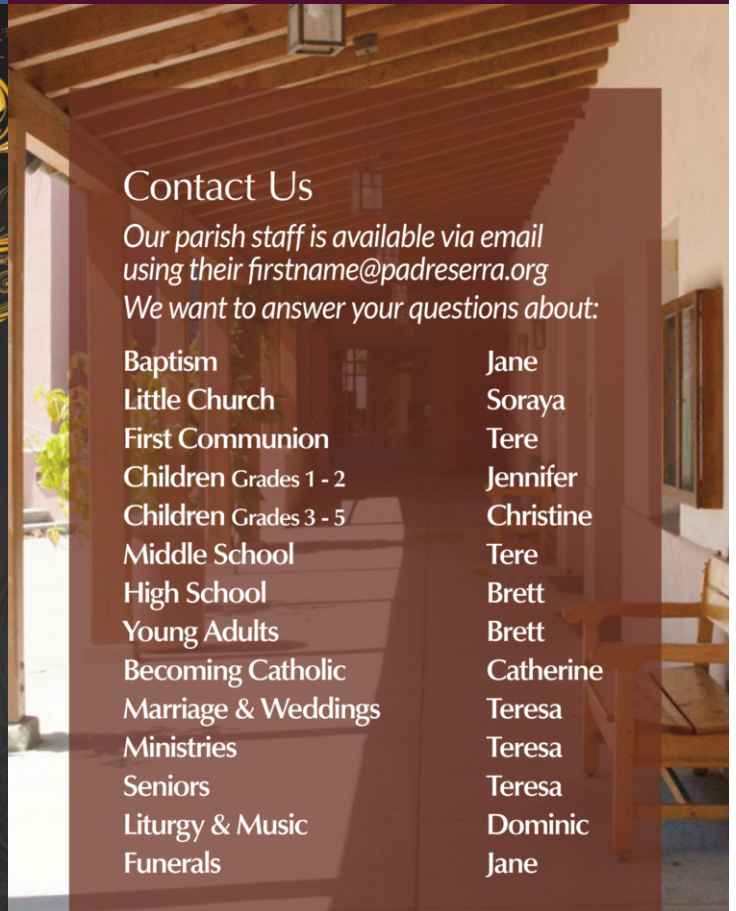
