

Communion procedure: After the Communion Invitation and its response ("Lord, I am not worthy..."), the presider and the deacons remain on the top step. The first five (six, if only one deacon) EMs who will serve the candidates (chosen and rehearsed previously) receive communion and go to their positions on the top step. EMs leave ciboria on the altar & distribute hosts to 1st Communicants from ciboria on altar. Meanwhile the candidates will line up in the north and south – going all the way to the carpet – and will receive communion on the top step of the altar:



After all the candidates have received, the EMs who were serving on the top, the presider and deacons move to their usual places. Any remaining EMs will receive then, and go to their usual places. Ushers will delay the assembly lining up for communion until the candidates have all received. As the EMs get into their normal positions, the assembly can line up for communion which continues in the usual way.
